



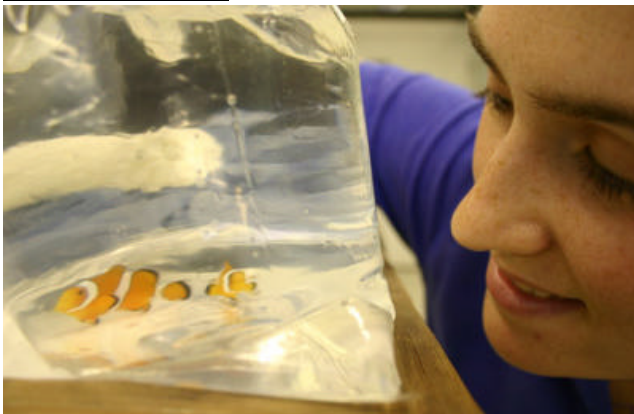

THE TIDELINE AQUATICS 3-DAY CONDITIONAL LIVESTOCK WARRANTY



In case you did not know, Tideline Aquatics offers a 3-day conditional livestock warranty. Please read this information so you will understand how our warranty works. The word “conditional” is added to our warranty because the livestock you purchase from us is guaranteed for three days if your aquarium water conditions are within a safe range for the addition of new livestock. Just because the animals in your aquarium are living does not mean the water in your aquarium is safe for new livestock. Water conditions can decline in an aquarium slowly allowing the established fish to acclimate over time to the adverse conditions. But when new livestock is added, it cannot adjust to the poor conditions with a simple one or two hour acclimation as the water parameters are so far out from acceptable safe levels. That said, if you purchase livestock from Tideline Aquatics and the animal dies within 3 days, it is fully covered as long as the water you added it to was safe for

new additions. So here are the details of our warranty.

HEALTHY PURCHASE GUARANTEE

All freshwater and saltwater fish and invertebrates are covered by a conditional replacement guarantee for a period of 3 days from the date of purchase. Live foods (feeder fish, ghost shrimp, etc), live plants and special order livestock are excluded (not included) from this guarantee.

CONDITIONS:

1. Livestock must be properly acclimated to the aquarium. New arrivals must be protected from aggression by the current tank mates.
2. Livestock must be returned for inspection along with the original Tideline sales receipt.
3. You **MUST** bring in a separate water sample (cannot have a dead animal in the water) for Tideline Aquatics to test (at no charge to you) to ensure the water parameters were within a safe range for adding a new livestock item.
4. Water parameters must be within these limits (see below) for a 100% replacement.

FRESHWATER LIVESTOCK

pH 6.5-7.5 (African cichlids up to 8.5)

Ammonia – less than .5ppm

Nitrite – less than .5ppm

KH (carbonate hardness) – 1-5dKH (Africans up to 15)

GH (general hardness) – 1-20dKH (Discus 1-10dKH)

Chlorine – must be zero of course

SALTWATER LIVESTOCK

pH 8.1-8.6

Ammonia – must be zero

Nitrite – must be zero

Nitrate (Fish) – less than 100ppm

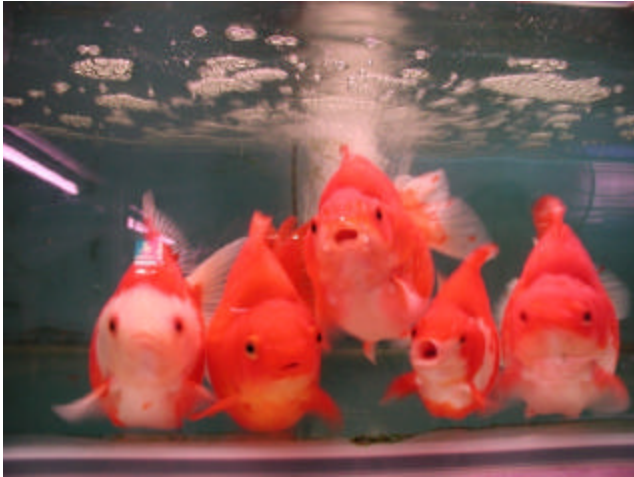
Nitrate (Invertebrates) – less than 20ppm

Chlorine – must be zero of course

Salinity (Fish) 1.016-1.025

Salinity (Invertebrates) 1.023-1.025

If water conditions exceed the above parameters, **Tideline Aquatics will replace 50% of the purchase price** once the customer corrects the water parameters in the aquarium. All guarantees are limited to replacement of the purchased livestock only. Tideline Aquatics cannot replace a loss due to neglect, abuse, pre-existing disease in the aquarium or from incompatibility with the existing livestock. Absolutely no cash refunds. If the water conditions were within a safe range, we will replace your purchase 100%.



Proper acclimation of your new livestock item will ensure a safe transition to your aquarium provided the water conditions are within a safe range for their survival. Fish and invertebrates react poorly to rapid changes in their environment. Here are our suggested acclimation procedures for new livestock being added to your aquarium:

ACCLIMATION PROCEDURE STANDARD METHOD –



Float the bag in the aquarium for 10-15 minutes to adjust the temperature of the bag water with the water in your aquarium. Then, open the bag and roll down the top of the bag with the bag floating on the surface. Do not allow the bag to collapse as the animal will suffocate. Add about 2-3 ounces of your aquarium water to the bag every 5-15

minutes until the water in the bag has doubled. Remove the animal from the bag and place it in the aquarium. Always discard the water remaining in the bag! Watch closely for signs of incompatibility with the existing organisms.

PREFERRED ADVANCED METHOD –



This method is called drip acclimation. We sell drip acclimators for just a few dollars and this method allows for the safest adjustment of new fish to the aquarium. First, float the sealed bag in the aquarium for 10-15 minutes to adjust the temperature to your aquarium temperature. Place the animal and bag water into a clean plastic container large enough for the animal to move around freely in the upright position (5 gallon bucket, etc). Place the container next to the aquarium. Using a drip acclimator, start a siphon of water from your aquarium into the container housing your new livestock item. Adjust the flow from the drip acclimator to 3-5 drips per second. Allow the water in the container to double before adding the new livestock to the aquarium. If multiple livestock items are being acclimated together, add light aeration during the acclimation procedure using a small air pump with an airstone. Watch for incompatibility once the new livestock item is added to the main aquarium.

And there you have it folks! Tideline Aquatics stands behind its livestock 100% but be aware that you must take responsibility too by ensuring the water in your aquarium is within a safe range for the addition of new animals. But if you don't realize that your water is unsafe and you lose a livestock purchase from us within three days, we will still give you a 50% credit once you correct the problem in the aquarium. Now that is a livestock guarantee everyone should agree with!
